The Shire of Quairading hereby confirms that it has resolved to make the Shire of Quairading Bush Fire Local Law 2023. The purpose of the proposed Bush Fire Brigades Local Law 2023 is so Council is acting legally with the establishment of the BFB and; The effect of the proposed Bush Fire Brigades Local Law 2023 will make the Shire of Quairading compliant with the requirements under the Bush Fires Act 1954 in reference to the establishment of a BFB. ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW - SHIRE OF QUIRADING REPEAL LOCAL LAW 2023

The Shire of Quairading hereby confirms that it has resolved to make the Shire of Quairading Repeal Local Law 2023.

The purpose of the Repeal Local Law 2023 is to provide for the repeal of defunct and obsolete Local Laws. The effect of the Repeal Local Law 2023 will be to allow Council to be more efficient and effective by removing defunct and outdated Local Laws from the public record and allow more flexibility in the town site with regards to what residents can build.
