SHIRE COMMUNITY & BUSINESS GRANTS PROGRAMS

If you own a business or operate a non-for-profit incorporated group or club within the Quairading Shire, you may be eligible to fund a project or event you want to get off the ground.

We've made a few small changes to our grant programs, the main change being that we will now fund up to 50% of the total project cost. We will also now be running two rounds of grants per financial year:

COMMUNITY GRANTS (SMALL GRANTS): Round 1 | \$500-\$2500 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | \$500-\$2500 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024. COMMUNITY GRANTS (MAJOR GRANTS): \$2500-\$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024. BUSINESS GRANTS: Round 1 | Up to \$5000 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | Up to \$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024. Application forms are available to download on our website www.quairading.wa.gov.au.
