2023 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTION - RESULTS

The nomination period for the 2023 Local Government Election officially closed at 4:00pm on Thursday, 7th September 2023. The Shire of Quairading had the following vacancies: 4 x 4-year terms and 3 x 2-year terms. The Returning Officer received seven nominations in total from (in alphabetical order): Ms Becky Cowcill, Ms Renee Faltyn, Ms Jo Hayes, Ms Jo Haythornthwaite, Mr Johnathan Hippisley, Mr Peter Smith and Mr Trevor Stacey. As nominations equalled the vacancies available, all nominees were declared elected unopposed by the Returning Officer and it was decided by draw of a ballot, which councillors would sit for the four-year terms, in accordance with the Local Government Act 1995 and the Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997.

The first four names drawn, and therefore, the councillors who will be sitting for a 4-year term, will be in order of the draw:

- Mr Trevor Stacey
- Ms Renee Faltyn
- Mr Peter Smith
- Mr Becky Cowcill

Councillors sitting for a 2-year term will be:

- Ms Jo Hayes
- Ms Jo Haythornthwaite
- Mr Johnathan Hippisley

The new Councillors will be sworn in after the terms of the retiring councillors finish on the 20th October 2023.
