TOWN ROADWORKS

Thursday 18th and Friday 19th of January. The work involves full width resealing of Jennaberring Road (York-Merredin Rd) from McLennan St to Loudon St within the town, and further east to Kelly Rd. Works will commence from 7am - 5pm, with stop/slow traffic control and utilise a bitumen sprayer, aggregate spreaders, suction sweepers and rollers. No excavation or vibration will be undertaken during the works. Residents will have access to their homes at all times during the works.
