### REDUCED SCHEME WATER SUPPLY

Tuesday 24th October, the Water Corporation are required to shut down Quairading's water supply on Tuesday the 24th of October. This is to enable an unserviceable fire hydrant on Weir Rd to be replaced. The town's water supply will be maintained via two water trucks, however, please try and limit any non-

### SHIRE COMMUNITY & BUSINESS GRANTS PROGRAMS

If you own a business or operate a non-for-profit incorporated group or club within the Quairading Shire, you may be eligible to fund a project or event you want to get off the ground.

We've made a few small changes to our grant programs, the main change being that we will now fund up to 50% of the total project cost. We will also now be running two rounds of grants per financial year:  
COMMUNITY GRANTS (SMALL GRANTS): Round 1 | \$500-\$2500 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | \$500-\$2500 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024.  
COMMUNITY GRANTS (MAJOR GRANTS): \$2500-\$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024  
BUSINESS GRANTS: Round 1 | Up to \$5000 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | Up to \$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024. Application forms are available to download on our website [www.quairading.wa.gov.au](http://www.quairading.wa.gov.au).
