PROPOSED OFF-LEASH DOG EXERCISE AREA

Did you know that there is currently no designated area in Quairading to exercise your dog off-leash? A proposed dedicated Off-Leash Dog Exercise Area (OLDEA) is currently being considered by Council at the Quairading Oval. The area would be a shared space with general oval users and include signage, more dog waste stations and a water station. Dog owners would be allowed to exercise their dogs off leash at all times, except during scheduled sporting events. ROAD WORKS NOTICE – DANGIN-MEARS RD

Contractors are replacing a large culvert on Dangin-Mears Rd. All vehicles will be detoured via Homebush Rd and Lake Mears Rd. All works will be conducted within the road closure. A reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place on Dangin Mears Rd on approach to the closure. A 60km/h speed limit will be in place on the Lake Mears Rd detour. We anticipate works to be completed by 28th March, 2024.
