MAIN ROADS

Main Roads wishes to advise that the following roadworks on the Bruce Rock Quairading Road will commence on 26 September 2023: Shoulder sealing between Shackleton and Bruce Rock. Works will be ongoing until the end of 2023. Audible edge lines will be installed after the roadworks Bridge works near Yoting which includes a bridge replacement and a road realignment. Works will be completed mid 2024, weather permitting. There will be lane closures for the roadworks so please allow additional time to travel. Further roadworks in 2024 are planned between York and Bruce Rock including pavement repairs and resealing works. Shoulder sealing between Gwambygine East Road and Halbert Road and between Yoting and Kwolyin is also planned for 2024.
