**PROPOSED OFF-LEASH DOG EXERCISE AREA**

Did you know that there is currently no designated area in Quairading to exercise your dog off-leash? A proposed dedicated Off-Leash Dog Exercise Area (OLDEA) is currently being considered by Council at the Quairading Oval. The area would be a shared space with general oval users and include signage, more dog waste stations and a water station. Dog owners would be allowed to exercise their dogs off leash at all times, except during scheduled sporting events.
