REFERENDUM VOTING

On Saturday 14th October you can vote at the Quairading Town Hall from 8am – 6pm. Early voting in other locations starts this weekend, find locations and hours via www.aec.gov.au/referendums – the nearest to us is Northam Town Hall which will be open the following hours; Mon 2 Oct – Fri 6 Oct: 8:30am–5:30pm. Sat 7 Oct: 9am–4pm. Mon 9 Oct – Thu 12 Oct: 8:30am–5:30 pm. Fri 13 Oct: 8:30am–6pm.

WHAT IS THE VOICE?

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice would be an independent and permanent advisory body. It would give advice to the Australian Parliament and Government on matters that affect the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. This includes issues such as education, health, housing, justice and other policies with a practical impact on First Nations people. If the referendum passes, there would be a process with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, the Parliament and the broader public to settle the Voice design. Legislation to establish the Voice would go through parliamentary processes to ensure

adequate scrutiny by elected representatives in both houses of Parliament. This would ensure the Voice can evolve and adapt as circumstances change, while upholding the authority of Parliament to legislate the Voice.

SHIRE COMMUNITY & BUSINESS GRANTS PROGRAMS

If you own a business or operate a non-for-profit incorporated group or club within the Quairading Shire, you may be eligible to fund a project or event you want to get off the ground. We've made a few small changes to our grant programs, the main change being that we will now fund up to 50% of the total project cost. We will also now be running two rounds of grants per financial year:
COMMUNITY GRANTS (SMALL GRANTS): Round 1 | \$500-\$2500 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | \$500-\$2500 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024.
COMMUNITY GRANTS (MAJOR GRANTS): \$2500-\$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024
BUSINESS GRANTS: Round 1 | Up to \$5000 | Open now | Closes 30th November 2023. Round 2 | Up to \$5000 | Open 1st March 2024 | Closes 30th April 2024. Application forms are available to download on our website www.quairading.wa.gov.au.
