NOTICE OF INTENT TO REPEAL LOCAL LAWS

The Shire of Quairading gives public notice of the intent to repeal two

Local Laws through the Repeal Local Law 2023:

1. *By-Law Relating to Buildings - Brick Area 1970.* 2. *By-Law Relating to Buildings - Brick Area Amendment 1995.* This is to provide for the repeal of defunct and obsolete Local Law and to allow Council to be more efficient and effective by removing defunct and outdated Local Laws from the public record and allow more flexibility in the town site with regards to what residents can build. Any submissions about the proposed Local Law should be made to the Shire CEO. The submission closing date is Sunday 16 April 2023.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT LOCAL LAW

As per Section 3.12 of the Local Government Act 1995, the Shire of Quairading gives public notice of the intent to enact the Bush Fire Brigade Local Law 2023. The purpose of this is so Council is acting legally with the establishment of the BFB and to ensure the Shire of Quairading are compliant with the requirements under the Bush Fires Act 1954 in reference to the establishment of a Bush Fire Brigade. Any submissions about the proposed Local Law should be made to the Shire CEO. The submission closing date is Sunday 16 April 2023.
